# Key National Data

- **3 in 5 people will be carers at some point in their lives and many of us in this room are or will be carers.**
- **Currently there are approximately 6.5 million carers in the UK**
- **Numbers of carers are rising - 11% in the last 10 years and projected to rise to 9 million by 2037**
- **In 2011 Carers UK estimated that carers saved the economy an estimated £119bn per year - higher than the annual net expenditure of the NHS for 2015/16 which about £116,574 billion**
- **Most carers are of working age, aged 50 - 64 years**
- **177,918 young people aged between 5 to 17 years undertaking caring responsibilities : 54% are girls and 46% are boys ( census data 2011)**

# Key Local Data – East of Berkshire

**2011 census number of people identified themselves as undertaken unpaid caring :**

- **Slough 11,626 of which 1,353 aged under 24**
- **Bracknell 9,601 of which 592 aged under 24**
- **Windsor & Maidenhead 13,125 of which 750 aged under 24**
